



## ATM AT WORK FOR YOU

**The African Transformation Movement (ATM) is currently not in any of the Municipalities. But with own limited funds, below this is a sample of some of the community projects that the ATM has successfully implemented:**

- Donating food parcel to poverty-stricken communities in various rural villages and townships across all nine provinces of South Africa, during Covid-19 Lockdown.
- Working very closely with multitude of Traditional Leaders and Religious Leaders giving the necessary support where required.
- More than 100 big water tanks given to each household of Ward 25 Xholobeni village in Bizana (Eastern Cape) to ensure that they have access to clean potable water.
- Building a fully furnished house for a poor household in ward 22 at eNtunjani village, Bizana (Eastern Cape).
- Building a Fully furnished house in Ward 24 at Sirhasheni village in Bizana (Eastern Cape).
- Ensuring that some communities of Waterberg municipality have access to clean and potable water by drilling a borehole.
- Funding a soccer and netball tournament with 20 youth teams in Ward 22, Lukholo Village, Bizana (Eastern Cape).
- Funding a netball and soccer tournament with a number of youth team in Ward 28, eLundini Village, Bizana (Eastern Cape)
- Donating various vegetable seedlings in a number of villages and Wards in Bizana (Eastern Cape).
- Building a fully furnished house for a child headed family in Matsulu township, Nelspruit (Mpumalanga).
- Donating various vegetable seedlings in a number of villages and Wards of Ngqeleni and Libode (Eastern Cape)
- Building a fully electrified bedroom house for a poor household in Ward 26 Mankosi village, Ngqeleni.
- Assisting to cultivate maize and vegetable fields including donating seeds for Ward 28, Ntibone village, Ngqeleni (Eastern Cape)
- Donated 500 chairs for Njiveni Tribal Authority, Libode under Chief Jongusapho.
- In Ward 32 in Ngqeleni, chairs were donated. 300 for Jujizweni Headman, Gxaba, 300 chairs for Gxaba High School and 200 chairs for the Gxaba creche.
- Donated maize seed and vegetable seedling in Ward 25, Xholobeni village, Bizana (Eastern Cape).
- Build a house for an elderly person in ePotshini village, Bergville (KwaZulu-Natal).
- Building houses for Qumbu and Tsolo deserving communities.
- A household with a burnt house was built a new house in Harding (KwaZulu-Natal).
- A burnt house for an elderly woman in the Free State was rebuilt.

## 1 BUILD CORRUPT-FREE, ACCOUNTABLE AND CAPABLE MUNICIPALITIES

- Transformed Municipalities : Peaceful, ethically-governed and economically viable Local Government.
- A corrupt-free administration through : lifestyle audits for Councillors and officials.
- Professionalize Municipalities with skilled officials – protected from political patronage.
- Strike a balance between outsourcing and insourcing to accelerate job creation
- Ensure sound financial management and internal controls - clean audit and good governance.

## 2 ENHANCE LOCAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT (LED) THAT SUPPORTS JOB CREATION & RURAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

- Prioritise capacitation of Co-operatives and other local SMMEs .
- Pays Service Providers within stipulated time frames, with special focus on SMMEs and Co-operatives.
- Upskill and assist with marketing of emerging farmers .
- Support the ocean economy in coastal towns to compete and have a booming fishing industry.
- Create sustainable livelihoods in rural areas: Rural infrastructure - agro-industries, Agri-parks, community production centres and other initiatives to eradicate rural poverty.

## 3 PROVIDE INTEGRATED SUSTAINABLE HUMAN SETTLEMENTS SUPPORTED BY RELIABLE BASIC SERVICES AND INFRASTRUCTURE

- Upgrade old and dilapidated Municipal-owned buildings to social housing facilities.
- Improve Municipal capacity for ongoing maintenance of roads, water supply, sewerage facilities and other Municipal infrastructure.
- Set realistic targets to eradicate informal settlement and ensure decent housing.
- Provide potable clean water, sanitation and affordable electricity in existing informal settlements.

## 4 CAPACITATE AND SKILL COMMUNITIES WITH FOCUS ON EMPOWERMENT OF WOMEN, YOUTH AND PEOPLE LIVING WITH DISABILITIES

- Increase entrepreneurial culture, technical skills and talents among all vulnerable groups through community skilling programmes.
- Support and professionalise sports, arts and culture within local communities to promote good health, reduce crime and drug abuse.

## 5 PROMOTE HEALTHY & ENVIRONMENTALLY PROTECTED COMMUNITY

- Monitor water quality and availability for human consumption, recreational and industrial use.
- Monitor and provide waste management systems: refuse, health care waste, hazardous waste and sewage.
- Ensure health inspectors monitor and ensure that all food during production, handling, storage, processing and distribution are safe, wholesome and good for human consumption

## ENABLERS

### a ELEVATE THE ROLE AND VALUE OF TRADITIONAL AND RELIGIOUS AFFAIRS

- Ensure Involvement and full participation of Traditional Leaders in Integrated Development Plan (IDP) processes;
- Ensure Municipal Councillors are held accountable for governance and clean administration by Traditional Leaders in their respective localities;
- Ensure full recognition, respect, dignity and support to all our kingdoms, kings, chiefs & traditional leadership.
- Promote equitable recognition, respect and support to all religious formations.

### b PROMOTE PEACE, JUSTICE, SAFETY AND SECURITY

- Educate and empower communities towards a law-abiding culture.
- Improve service delivery and accountability to limit and avoid service delivery protests.
