ATM AT WORK FOR YOU

The African Transformation Movement (ATM) is currently not in any of the municipalities. But with own limited funds, below is just a sample of some of the community projects that the ATM successfully implemented:

- Donating food parcels to poverty-stricken communities in various rural villages and townships across all nine provinces of South Africa, during Covid-19 Lockdown.
- Working very closely with multitude of Traditional Leaders and religious leaders giving the necessary support where required.
- More than 100 big water tanks given to each household of ward 25 Xholobeni Village in Bizana (Eastern Cape) to ensure that they have access to clean potable water.
- Building a fully furnished house for a poor household in ward 22 at eNtunjeni village, Bizana (Eastern Cape).
- » Building a fully furnished house in Ward 24 at Sirhasheni village in Bizana (Eastern Cape).
- Ensuring that some communities of Waterberg Municipality (Limpopo) have access to clean and potable water by drilling a borehole.
- Funding a soccer and netball tournament with 20 youth teams in Ward 22, Lukholo Village, Bizana (Eastern Cape).
- Funding a netball and soccer tournament with a number of youth teams in Ward 28, eLundini Village, Bizana (Eastern Cape)
- >> Donating various vegetable seedlings in a number of villages and Wards in Bizana (Eastern Cape).
- Building a full furnished house for a child headed family in Matsulu township, Nelspruit (Mpumalanga).
- Donating various vegetable seedlings in a number of villages and wards of Ngqeleni and Libode (Eastern Cape)
- Building a fully electrified two-bedroom house for a poor household in Ward 26 Mankosi village, Ngqeleni (Eastern Cape).
- Assisting to cultivate maize and vegetable fields including donating seeds for Ward 28, Ntibane village, Ngqeleni (Eastern Cape).
- » Donated 500 chairs for Njiveni Tribal Authority, Libode (Eastern Cape) under Chief Jongusapho.
- In Ward 32 in Ngqeleni (Eastern Cape), chairs were donated. 300 chairs for Jujizweni Headman, 300 chairs for Gxaba High School and 200 chairs for the Gxaba creche.
- » Donated maize seed and vegetable seedling in Ward 25, Xholobeni village, Bizana (Eastern Cape).
- >> Building a house for an elderly person in ePotshini village, Bergville (KwaZulu-Natal).
- » Building houses for Qumbu and Tsolo deserving communities.
- >> A household with a burnt house was built a new house in Harding (KwaZulu-Natal).
- » Burnt house for an elderly woman in the Free State was rebuilt.
- School shoes and uniform was given to Goqwana Primary School deserving children from poor communities of Ward 6, Tsolo (Eastern Cape).
